In case of unauthorized absence of candidate for one month or more after getting admitted to the course, the candidate will be treated as having discontinued without notice and the vacancy will be filled up from the waiting list depending on the availability of time before the prescribed cut-off date. Candidates will have to give a declaration to this effect at the time of Admission.(As in Annexure – IV) Those service candidates selected by TNPSC/MRB who have put in less than two 13. years of continuous regular service as on 31.10.2023 will be treated as Non-Service candidates.

14. All others who have put in less than two years of service or who are probationers in Central Government, Public Sector undertaking, Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS), Local bodies, National Rural Health Mission and Municipalities in Tamil Nadu and Tamil Nadu Government undertakings and organizations will be treated as Non-Service candidates.

## 15. **ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:**

The Selection Committee will allot seats to the Branches of study based on the merit and following 200 points roster based upon the seat matrix provided by the affiliating University the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University and subject to the availability of seats at the time of individual's turn.

Apportionment of seats between the Government and Management of Self Financing Minority Institutions is in the ratio of 50:50 of the 85% of the sanctioned strength of seats after surrendering 15% of the sanctioned strength of seats towards All India Quota (AIQ).

# 16. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO M.D. (HOMOEOPATHY) COURSE UNDER GOVERNMENT SURRENDERED QUOTA.

i) A person holding the degree of:

Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and surgery or equivalent qualification in Homoeopathy included in the schedule to the Act, after undergoing a course of study of not less than five years and six months duration including one year compulsory internship;

- **ii**) The candidate enrolled in Central Register of Homoeopathy or Tamil Nadu Homoeopathy Medical Council shall be eligible for admission in the Post Graduate courses, with successful completion of CRRI before the date fixed by NCH / AIAPGET Homoeopathy 2023.
- iii) The candidates should fulfill the eligibility criteria for applying AIAPGET 2023 and should have obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the 'All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIAPGET)' held for the year 2023. Provided that in respect of candidates belonging to the scheduled castes, scheduled castes (Arunthathiyar), scheduled Tribes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Community, Backward classes (Muslim), Backward classes; the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile; for candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of persons with disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for the General category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for the scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Community, Backward Classes (Muslim), Backward classes.

**Note**: Provided further that when sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in the AIAPGET 2023, as specified above, held for 2023 academic year for admission to Post – Graduate courses, the central government in consultation with the council may at its discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to Post – Graduate course for candidates belonging to respective categories and marks so lowered by

17. At the time of counselling, candidate should produce the original documents such as the II Provisional Certificate or Degree Certificate from the recognized University and Medical Registration Certificate issued by NCH / Tamil Nadu Homoeopathy Medical Council, Chennai.

- 18. The Candidate should be a Citizen of India and should have undergone B.H.M.S. Course in the State of Tamil Nadu. Candidates of Tamil Nadu nativity who have completed B.H.M.S. Course in other States shall furnish a Certificate of Nativity in Tamil Nadu issued by a competent authority only in the specified format prescribed in the application (see Annexure I), and should also produce the Eligibility Certificate from the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University before Counseling or before attending the Counseling failing which they will not be considered for Selection.
- 19. Hall Ticket Roll Number and Marks scored in AIAPGET 2023 (Homoeopathy) are to be filled in the relevant columns of the Application Form. Only Photostat Self Attested copies of the Hall Ticket and Marks Statement should be enclosed with the Application Form. Original Hall Ticket and Marks Statement must be produced only at the time of Counseling and Admission.

## 20. **NOT ELIGIBLE**

- (i) Candidates who join a Post Graduate Degree in any branch and discontinue the course on any grounds after the cutoff date fixed by NCH are not eligible to apply for two subsequent academic years.
- (ii) Candidates who have completed a Post Graduate Degree or the candidates who possess a Post Graduate Degree in one Specialty / Branch of study are not eligible to apply for admission to any other Post Graduate degree i.e., in other branches.
- (iii)List of Candidates given as **NOT Eligible to attend counselling by AYUSH Admissions Central Counselling Committee (AACCC) from time to time.**

their studies on or after the cut-off date for admission processes relevant to the particular admission session may also have to fore go the Tuition fees and other kinds of fees remitted to the college authority during the period of study.

Thus, the candidates who discontinue their study before the completion of M.D.(Homoeopathy) course are liable to fulfil the above three conditions.

- Service Candidates selected to the course should execute a bond in the prescribed form available at the College at the time of admission, for Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) along with three sureties in permanent Government Service of equal rank or higher rank than the candidate for an equivalent amount at the time of admission, in pursuance of their undertaking to the effect that they shall serve the concerned Government or local body, etc. for a minimum period of five years after the completion of the course. If the service candidate serves for a period less than five years, the proportion of the salary and stipend or other payments made to the candidate during the course period in relation to the ratio of period in whole months served over the requirement of sixty months shall be treated as the candidate entitlement and the remaining amount which relates to the short fall and period of commitment shall be recovered from the service candidate or paid by candidate prior to candidate's discharge from service.
- 40. The examination fee will be collected at the rate prescribed by the University from time to time
