- 3. The candidates are instructed to visit the website at least two times a day for updates from the date of issue of Application till the end of Admission process without fail. Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of Notices, Notification and Publications appearing on the Website regarding Admission to Post Graduate Degree courses in Unani, M.D. (Unani) for 2024-2025 session.
- 4. Candidates are advised to read the Information Bulletin for AIAPGET-2024 (Unani) issued by National Testing Agency (NTA) carefully and visit the website <u>www.ntaaiapget.nic.in</u> for detailed qualifying criteria for admission to Post Graduate Degree in M.D. (Unani) 2024-2025 session.
- 5. All Candidates who apply for the Post Graduate M.D (Unani) should remit a nonrefundable amount of Rs.3000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) towards Application Cost, through SBI Collect. The candidates belonging to SC/SCA/ST are exempted from paying Application Cost. The SC/SCA/ST candidates are requested to submit 3 photocopies of community certificate for their claim for exemption. - 6. **PAYMENT OF COURSE FEE:**

The candidates who are selected at the time of counseling shall remit a nonrefundable sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) by Cash / Demand Draft (DD in favour of the Director, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy Department, Chennai 600 106) only, at the time of receipt of the allotment order. After the receipt of the joining report from the Principal of Government Unani Medical College this amount will be transferred to the College to get adjusted with the Tuition Fees payable by the candidates. 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I. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. DOWNLOADING OF APPLICATION

Before filling up of the Application Form (downloaded from www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in) in the Prescribed format, the applicant should read all the instructions given in the Prospectus and Application form carefully.

- 2. Fill the Application carefully and legibly without overwriting and in one's own hand writing. All pages in the application should be signed in full, by the applicant.
- 3. All the enclosures prescribed should be Self Attested true photocopies only. The Originals should be produced only at the time of Counselling and Admission.
- 4. Application with incomplete or insufficient particulars or without enclosures or those received after the last date mentioned will be summarily rejected. Further, request for extension of time for submission of documents beyond the prescribed date and time shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

5. APPLICATION SUBMISSION

6. Service Candidates

Service Candidates should forward their application only through the proper channel with the remarks of the forwarding authorities in the format prescribed in the Application form. It should compulsorily reach on or before the last date as mentioned above. If not, Applications will be summarily rejected irrespective of the date of submission by the Applicant and date of forwarding by the competent authority. Advance copies from the service candidates will not be accepted. **They should have obtained qualification marks in AIAPGET 2024 (UNANI).**

7. Non-service Candidates

Non-service Candidates should send their applications directly to the Secretary, Selection Committee Office.

- 8. A Self attested passport size photograph should be affixed in the front page of the application form in the space provided. The Photograph should be identical to the photograph attached in AIAPGET 2024 (Unani) Hall Ticket.
- 9. If a candidate desires an immediate acknowledgement, should advise the postal or courier service and pay the required fees themselves. Acknowledgement Card confirming receipt of Application with required particulars (Application Registration Number) will be sent subsequently to candidates who are found to be prima facie eligible if sufficient time is available before Counselling or else the Candidate may visit the website for General Merit list.
- 10. All information pertaining to MD (Unani) admission will be notified in the Department's official website **"www. tnhealth.tn.gov.in"** from time to time. Candidates are advised to check / visit the website minimum twice daily for PG Merit List, Counselling Schedule, any further information / intimations etc., The Selection Committee will not be responsible, if any candidate failed to appear for the Counselling. No individual correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
- 11. Persons with Bench Mark Disability should obtain Medical and Eligibility certificate from Designated Disability Centre such as Madras Medical College / Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, and to submit the same along with application as per Annexure – III.
- 12. Unauthorised absence

In case of unauthorized absence of candidate for one month or more after getting admitted to the course, the candidate will be treated as having discontinued without notice and the vacancy will be filled up from the waiting list depending on the availability of time before the prescribed cut-off date. Candidates will have to give a declaration to this effect at the time of Admission. (As in Annexure - IV)

13. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

The Selection Committee will allot seats to the Colleges and Branches of study based on the merit and following 200 points roster depending upon the seat matrix provided by the affiliating University and subject to the availability of seats at the time of individual's turn. **If candidates of particular community is not available in the merit list, the next turn**

will be considered till filling up of all seats based on 200 points roster.

II. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO M.D.(Unani) COURSE

14. i) A person holding the degree of kamile Tib-o-Jarahat (Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery) or equivalent degree from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University or from any other recognized University or Board or Medical Institution included in the second schedule to the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 or National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, and enrolled in Central Register of Indian System of Medicine or Tamil Nadu Board of Indian Medicine shall be eligible for admission in the Post – Graduate Courses with successful completion of CRRI before the date fixed by the NCISM / AIAPGET-2024 for this purpose.

ii) The candidates should fulfill the eligibility criteria for applying AIAPGET 2024 and should have obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the 'All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIAPGET)' held for the year 2024. Provided that in respect of candidates belonging to the scheduled castes, scheduled castes (Arunthathiyar), scheduled Tribes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Backward classes (Muslim) and Backward classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile; for candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of persons with disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for the General category and 40th percentile for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Most Backward Classes (Muslim) and Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Backward Classes (Muslim) and Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Backward Classes (Muslim) and Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Backward Classes (Muslim) and Backward classes.

Note: Provided further that when sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in the AIAPGET-2024, as specified above, for admission to Post – Graduate courses, the central government in consultation with the council may at its discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to Post – Graduate course for candidates belonging to respective categories and marks so lowered by the central government shall be applicable for that academic year only.

- 15. The candidate should produce the Degree Certificate or the Provisional Certificate II issued by the Affiliating University and Medical Registration Certificate issued by Tamil Nadu Board of Indian Medicine, Chennai, in Original at the time of counselling.
- 16. The Candidate should be a Citizen of India and should have undergone B.U.M.S. Course in the State of Tamil Nadu. Candidates of Tamil Nadu nativity who have completed B.U.M.S. Course in other States shall furnish a Certificate of Nativity in Tamil Nadu issued by a

competent authority only in the specified format prescribed in the application, and should also produce the Eligibility Certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University before attending the Counselling.

17. Hall Ticket Roll / Register Number and Marks scored in AIAPGET–2024 (Unani) should be filled in the relevant columns of the Application Form. Photostat Self Attested copies of the Hall Ticket and Marks Statement should be enclosed with the Application Form. Original Hall Ticket and Marks Sheet of AIAPGET (Unani) 2024 must be produced only at the time of Counseling and Admission.

III NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO M.D.(Unani) COURSE

- Candidates who joined a Post Graduate Degree in any branch and discontinued the course on any grounds after the cutoff date fixed by NCISM are not eligible to apply for two subsequent academic years.
 - Candidates who have completed a Post Graduate Degree or the candidates who possess a Post Graduate Degree in one Specialty / Branch of study are not eligible to apply for admission to any other Post Graduate degree i.e., in other branches.
 - 3. List of Candidates given as **NOT Eligible by AYUSH Admissions Central Counselling Committee (AACCC) from time to time.**

IV. MODE OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION

19. (i) For non – Service candidates:

Admission to the course will be made purely on merit, based on the marks obtained in the AIAPGET-2024 (UNANI).

(ii) For Service Candidates:

The State Rank list will be drawn based on marks obtained in AIAPGET-2024 (UNANI) and additional weightage marks awarded to eligible in-service Candidates. One mark will be awarded for each completed year of Government Service. Two marks will be awarded for each completed year of Government service in Hill areas and it will be limited to maximum of 10 marks.

20. Declaration of Merit list:

For non – service candidates merit will be arrived based on the marks obtained in the AIAPGET-2024 (Unani). For service candidates merit will be arrived as mentioned in clause 19 (ii)

- 21. In case more than one candidate has secured the same number of marks (Total marks obtained in the AIAPGET-2024 (Unani) together with additional weightage awarded for service rendered if applicable as per the G.O. (Ms.) No.320 Health and Family Welfare (IM 1-2) Department, dated: 26.09.2023, the tie shall be resolved on the basis of the rank obtained in the AIAPGET-2024 (UNANI).
- 22. Tentative rank list will be published in the official website <u>www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in</u> after completion of scrutiny of all applications received for the academic year 2024-2025.

V. COUNSELLING

- 23. Personal appearance during counselling along with all original certificates / documents is compulsory for all eligible candidates applying for admission to the Post-Graduate courses to verify identity with reference to the attested copies enclosed with the Application. The candidates will be called as per Rank in Merit list and the seats will be filled as per Rank in Merit list and communal reservation **resources**, in case of any candidates without original certificates / documents who attended first phase of counselling, will **NOT** be allowed to participate in second or subsequent phases of counselling. No separate letter for counselling will be issued. **Candidates who are absent at the time of Counselling will not be considered for selection and no protest will be admitted in this regard**.
- 24. Allotment of Branches will be made at the time of Counselling to be conducted by the Selection Committee at the campus of the Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine, Arumbakkam, Chennai 106 based on rank in the merit list. **Branch once opted and allotted to the candidate at the time of Counselling is final and cannot be changed subsequently under any circumstances for that particular Phase of counselling.**
- 25. If any vacancy arises in Phase I, the seats will be filled in Phase II as per the Rank in merit list and communal reservation. Candidates who were absent in Phase I or who have not joined the allotted course in Phase I will not be permitted to attend Phase II.
- 26. The candidate cannot claim the seats which were available during Phase I, during his / or her turn, in subsequent phases.
- 27. Candidates allotted seat in special category are not eligible for General Counselling.
- 28. The number of seats available in MD (Unani) Couse and seats in specialisation is subject to change based on the approval and allotment by Ministry of AYUSH. However, the exact distribution of seats, Specialty wise will be displayed on the notice board at the Selection Committee, Directorate of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy before the commencement of Counselling on receipt of seat matrices from the affiliating University before the counselling schedule for P.G. courses.

- 29. The selection will be made by counselling based on Merit and by applying the 200 points Roster method followed by the Government of Tamil Nadu, since the available number of seats is less than 8 in each speciality.
- 30. Any remaining unfilled seats for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to SCA communities shall be filled by candidates belonging to SC community other than Arunthathiyars as per merit and vice versa.
- 31. Any remaining reserved seats in ST quota for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to ST community shall be allotted to candidates belonging to SC community as per merit.
- 32. Any remaining unfilled seats in BCM Community for want of adequate number of eligible candidates after exhausting the merit list shall be filled up on merit basis by candidates belonging to BC community without exceeding the quota for BC community as a whole.

VI -COVID PRECAUTIONS INSTRUCTION

33. The candidates and their parents are instructed to follow the standard preventive measures of COVID-19 during the counselling as per Government orders from time to time.

34. **Tuition Fees**

Candidates who are selected at the time of counselling shall make a Non-refundable fee deposit of a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) **by Cash / Demand Draft (DD)** immediately to the Committee and will there upon be issued a formal provisional Allotment order. No allotment order will be issued if payment is not made immediately and the seat will be allotted to the next meritorious candidate. After receipt of the joining report from the Principal, Govt. Unani Medical College, Chennai, this amount will be transferred to the college concerned to be adjusted with the tuition fees payable by the candidate. If the candidate fails to join the course within the stipulated day / time after getting allotment order he/she shall forfeit this amount and any other payments done by him/her and lose the right to join the current session of the MD (Unani) Programme.

Processing Fees

All the candidates appearing for M.D (<u>Unani</u>) course counselling will have to remit a nonrefundable amount of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) **by Cash towards** processing fee for counselling.

VII - ANNUAL FEE PAYABLE FOR -M.D.(UNANI)

- 35. Every student has to pay for special fee and sports and welfare fund every year. The fee prescribed is subject to revision from time to time.
- 36. The examination fee will be collected at the rate prescribed by The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University from time to time
- 37. The Post Graduate Degree course M.D (Unani) admissions for 2024-2025 session will be closed on the cut - off date of admission as prescribed by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine / The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University for the academic year 2024-2025.
- 38. The candidates who join Post Graduate Degree course should not indulge in any kind of agitation / strike / ragging activity inside / outside the college campus during the course of study. If Candidates found to take part in any of such activities mentioned above will be expelled from the course / college at any part of the course of study, criminal action will be taken against them.

39. Seats reserved for Service Candidates

50% of seats in each specialty are reserved for service candidates, in addition to those service candidates can also opt in Open Category based on the General Merit and communal rotation. If the reserved seats for Service candidates are not filled due to lack of eligible candidates in merit list, the seats will be converted to General category and filled by Non service candidates based on Merit and Communal rotation.

43. SERVICE CANDIDATES

The following categories of Unani Medical Graduates only will be treated as Service candidates and considered for selection against seats reserved exclusively for service candidates.

(i) Unani Medical Graduates who have been selected by the Tamil Nadu Public Service

Commission / Medical services Recruitment Board and appointed in the Tamil Nadu Medical Service on regular basis, who have put in minimum of TWO years satisfactory and continuous service excluding leave period such as Earned Leave, Unearned Leave on Medical Certificate, Unearned Leave on Private Affairs, Maternity Leave and any other unauthorized absence, as on 31.07.2024 either in Tamil Nadu Medical Service or local bodies and organizations. Candidates above 50 years as on 31.07.2024 are not eligible to apply.

- (ii) Unani Medical Graduates who are approved Probationers and who are working
 - a. As Medical Officers (working continuously for two years) in Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu. A doctor absorbed from the Panchayat Union into Government Service as per G.O.Ms. No 435 / Health and Family Welfare / IM1-2 Department dated: 23-11-2000 will be considered as Service Candidates provided that they should have completed 2 years of service.
 - b. In Government of India Institutions in the State.
 - c. In Public Sector Undertaking and Organizations under the Control of Government of India in Tamil Nadu.
 - d. An undertaking or organization of Government of Tamil Nadu.
- **44.** The Service candidates should give an undertaking to the concerned authorities that they will serve for 5 years in the respective institutions after the completion of course. They should produce a certificate from the concerned authority to show that they have given such an undertaking.
- 45.

NON-SERVICE CANDIDATES

The following categories of Unani Medical Graduates will be treated as Non- Service Candidates.

- (a) The service candidates selected through TNPSC/MSRB, who have put in less than two years of continuous regular State Government Service as on 31.07.2024 will be treated as Non-Service Candidates.
- (b) All Unani Medical Graduates who have not been selected by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission/Medical services Recruitment Board and are appointed on Temporary basis under Rule10 (a) (i) in the Tamil Nadu Medical Service.
- (c) All Unani Medical graduates who have put in less than two years of service as on 31.07.2024 in Central Government, Public Sector undertaking, Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS), Local bodies, National Rural Health Mission and

Municipalities in Tamil Nadu and Tamil Nadu Government Undertakings and Organizations.

(d) Private Registered Unani Medical Practitioners.

X. STIPEND TO NON-SERVICE CANDIDATE

- 46. It should be noted carefully that the MD (Unani) Course is a full-time programme where the candidate is expected to be exposed on all days to a variety of patients. Therefore, students shall not participate in any activity outside the college or additional to the course or medical duties and no permission shall be available for the same for any reason whatsoever.
- 47. All the Post Graduate students shall attend the Out Patient ward session, for both clinical and non-clinical Post Graduate courses and In-Patient ward session in case of clinical Post Graduate Courses and the theory classes for all the Post Graduate courses every day without fail and regularly. In case, a student attends only Outpatient session or In-patient ward session and does not attend the Theory classes or vice versa, such Post Graduate student shall not be eligible for any stipend for the day since the M.D (Unani) is a full-time course. Every student shall fulfil the minimum required attendance percentage as prescribed by The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai from time to time for becoming eligible to take up the examination of the said University. If a Post Graduate student is not permitted to take up the said University's examinations as per the regulations in force and amended from time to time and consequently if the period of study is extended, no stipend shall be paid to such student for such period of extension of study. The Post Graduate students shall be subject to the rules, regulations, conventions and practice being followed in the hospital and the concerned medical college and code of conduct, rules etc., as laid down by the Government, The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University and the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, New Delhi from time to time.
- 48. In case of breach of any such rules, regulations etc., as stated above, the Principal, Government Unani Medical College, Chennai, shall take appropriate disciplinary action against such student including the disqualification of the student to continue further post graduate studies and communicate the same to The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University.

49. SALARY FOR THE SERVICE CANDIDATES IN LIEU OF STIPEND:

Candidates who have been regularly appointed in the Tamil Nadu Medical Service alone will be paid salary as per Government orders in force. Service Candidates from Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu, Government of India Institutions in the State in Public Sector Undertaking and Organizations under the Control of Government of India in Tamil Nadu, an undertaking or organization of Government of Tamil Nadu will not be paid any salary by the Government during the period of study.

- 50. Service candidates will not be eligible for study leave. The entire period spent by service candidates for undergoing M.D.(Unani) course with salary will be treated as on duty for all purpose viz. increment, pension, etc., except for the purpose of Pay and Leave.
- 51. In case, where the study period is to be counted towards probation period, orders of the Government have to be obtained for the relaxation of the relevant rules.
- 52. No paid post will be given to candidates who are selected for M.D.(Unani) Course and they shall work full time in the Department of their respective specialties. They should not indulge in private practice during the period of study.
- 53. (i) All Candidates (Service and Non-Service) undergoing the M.D.(Unani) course should execute a Bond as per Annexure V to the effect that in the event of discontinuing their studies before completion of the course, they shall be liable for refund of the full amount of stipend received by them till the day of discontinuation along with three sureties in permanent Government Service of equal rank or above at the time of admission to the course.

(ii) Further, the Candidates who discontinue the course on or after the last date of allotment of seats / cut-off date for admission processes pertaining to the Academic session 2024 - 2025 as fixed by Ministry of AYUSH / Affiliating University, shall pay the Discontinuation Fees of a sum of Rupees Ten Lakhs by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Director of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai -106" payable at Chennai. Unless the penalty amount is paid in total, the Candidates will not be relieved and original certificates / documents will be retained by the college authorities. All candidates shall execute a bond to this effect at the time of admission to the College.

(iii) Candidates pursuing M.D. (Unani) course in the event of discontinuing their studies on or after the cut-off date for admission process relevant to the particular admission session may also have to fore go the Tuition fees and other kinds of fees remitted to the college authority during the period of study.

Thus, the candidates who discontinue their study before the completion of M.D. (Unani) course are liable to fulfill the above three conditions.

54.

Service Candidates selected to the course should execute a bond in the prescribed form

available as in Annexure- V at the time of admission, for Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) along with three sureties in permanent Government Service of equal rank or higher rank than the candidate for an equivalent amount at the time of admission, in pursuance of their undertaking to the effect that they shall serve the concerned Government or local body, etc. for a minimum period of five years after the completion of the course. If the service candidate serves for a period of less than five years, the proportion of the salary and stipend or other payments made to the candidate during the course period in relation to the ratio of period in whole months served over the requirement of sixty months shall be treated as the candidate entitlement and the remaining amount which relates to the short fall and period of commitment shall be recovered from the service candidate or paid by candidate prior to candidate's discharge from service.

55. Candidates undergoing the MD (Unani) Course who have secured appointment in Tamil Nadu Medical Service through the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission / Medical Services Recruitment Board shall not be permitted to discontinue the course without satisfying the condition of their bond. They shall also not be permitted to re-join the MD programme midway at a later point of time or retain rights to join the M.D programme without completing the waiting period and without appearing in the AIAPGET-2024 (UNANI) pertaining to the relevant academic year except in accordance with orders of Government through Health Department regulating readmission in respect of such discontinuance.
