  - b. Permanently residing for a period of 5 years should be supported by documentary evidence.
  - c. The family ration card, Electoral Roll, census list if taken recently, documents like sale deed, tax receipt etc. relating to the property owned by either of the parents or by the applicant may be verified.
  - d. The Transfer Certificate issued by the school authorities where the applicant had studied last may be verified to know whether he/she was in the state for 7 years.
  - e. Enquiry in the village/ place of residence of the neighbor / Village Administrative Officers regarding continuous residing.
  - f. To ensure that wrong or in correct address had not been furnished to obtain the certificate.
  - g. The birth place of the parent, place of the residence of the parent/ father, permanent assets, mother tongue, place of education, place of marriage of the applicant/ parents, the period of stay in and outside Tamil Nadu can also be considered before issuing certificate.


