(iii) Further, to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses, Candidates must have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (Academic) conducted by the Tamil Nadu State Board or any other equivalent Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology and English individually and must have obtained minimum of **fifty percent** of marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and **forty percent** mark in the case of BC/BC(M)/MBC/DC/SC/SCA/ST category.
