2.	<b>METHOD OF APPLICATION FEE PAYMENT:</b> Application cost should be paid by Cash when submission of application on the day of counselling.
3.	All the candidates should submit the filled in application form downloaded from the website, with all the required documents along with the details of payment of <b>Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) towards the application cost.</b>

1.	<b>ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: -</b>
	Candidate should be a citizen of India.
2.	<b>AGE LIMIT:</b>
	Candidates should have completed the age of Seventeen years on or before 31st December 2024. Evidence for the age (e.g., Birth Certificate, 10 <sup>th</sup> Mark Sheet, +2 Mark sheet, etc.) should be produced.
3.	<b>EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:</b>
i.	<p>Candidates should have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination conducted by The Tamil Nadu State Board or any other equivalent Board in the following group of subjects along with English individually.</p> <p>(a) Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. (or)</p> <p>(b) Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any other subject.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Candidates who have passed in other board of examination (i.e., other than the Tamil Nadu State Board, CBSE and ISCE) with same subjects as mentioned above in Clause 3 should produce the Eligibility Certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University before attending the Counselling.</p>
ii.	<p>Candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from <i>National Institute of Open Schooling*</i> <b>or</b> <i>State Open Schools*</i> <b>or</b> <i>as private candidates*</i> from recognized State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as an additional subject shall be allowed but subject to the outcome of Special Leave Petitions / Appeals filed by the Medical Council of India.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> <i>*“The proviso in italics has been a subject matter of challenge before the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi, Hon’ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, and Hon’ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. The provisions of the regulations disqualifying recognized Open School Board candidates and the candidates who have studied Biology/Biotechnology as an Additional Subject has been struck down.”</i></p>

4.	<p><b>ELIGIBILITY FOR MINORITY SEATS:</b></p> <p>The Candidates who are eligible to claim Religious Minority seats which is a Notified Minority Community as per section 2(c) of National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 should produce the Study Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last studied as prescribed in the Annexure– I or a certificate issued by the competent revenue authority of the candidate’s native jurisdiction as prescribed in the Annexure – I (A). The Candidates submitting these Annexures in full form alone will be given preference in Minority Colleges as per their Minority Status.</p>																			
5.	<p><b>The following categories of candidates are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for B.N.Y.S. Course.</b></p>																			
a.	<p>Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Certificate Examination in Vocational Stream, Pre-University Course in Tamil Nadu, and who used scribe, who did not study English as a subject in Higher Secondary Examination.</p>																			
b.	<p>Candidates presently pursuing the B.N.Y.S. Course.</p>																			
c.	<p>The selection and admission of candidates of other than those in Clause 3 will be provisional subject to recognition of the qualifying examination by The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. 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8.	<p><b>DURATION OF THE BNYS COURSE:</b></p> <p>The duration of BNYS course is five and half years including one year of Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship.</p>									
9.	<b>DETERMINATIONS OF RANK OF THE CANDIDATES:</b>									
a.	Ranking will be made by merit on the basis of marks obtained by the eligible candidates in the prescribed Science subjects in the qualifying examinations reduced to the base of 200									

marks. The marks obtained through different Boards of Examination will be taken into account after normalization of marks.

b. **Normalization of Marks:**

i.) The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authority will be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of Tamil Nadu by adopting the method of normalization.

**Explanation:** - Under the method of normalization, the highest mark obtained by the students of various Boards in each subject will be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of State Board in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject will be determined accordingly.

**Illustration:** - If the highest mark secured by the student of State Board in Physics is 100, and the highest mark secured by the student of any other Board in the same subject is 90, both the highest mark will be considered to be equal to 100. If the student of the Other Board secures 60 marks in Physics when the highest mark in Physics in the same board is 90, the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived at below: -

$$100 \times 60/90 = 66.66\%$$

ii) After normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by different Boards, the qualified students of different Boards will be merged into a common merit list.

c.	<p><b>Determination of Rank of Candidates Obtaining Equal Marks (Inter Se Merit):</b>  In cases, where two or more candidates obtain equal aggregated marks for 200, the rank of such candidates shall be determined on the basis of the following order :-</p> <p>(i) Percentage in Biology or Botany and Zoology taken together in qualifying examination.  (ii) Percentage in Chemistry in qualifying examination.  (iii) Percentage in fourth optional subject in qualifying examination.  (iv) Date of Birth- Weightage given to seniority in age  (v) Computerized Random number assigned. Higher value of Random Number will be taken into Consideration.</p>
10.	The Rank / Merit list will be published on the notice board at the office of the Selection Committee.
11.	The selection will be made by counselling based on the merit only.
12.	All selections and admissions to BNYS course are only provisional. The selection and admission are liable to be cancelled at any time as and when the eligibility conditions are found to be defective or incorrect or of any suppression of facts deliberately or otherwise. The right of allotment to BNYS Course and College is vested totally with the Selection Committee.
13.	<p><b>COUNSELLING:</b>  <b>Selection of candidates will be done through counselling based on the merit.</b></p>
i.	<p><b>a)</b> Selection Committee is the designated authority that conducts counselling for admissions to BNYS course in all Government and Self-Financing Yoga and Naturopathy Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu.</p> <p><b>b)</b> No authority or Institution shall admit any candidate to the undergraduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by the Selection Committee in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged.</p>
ii.	Counselling Schedule will be made available on the website ( <a href="http://www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in">www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in</a> ). Candidates can attend the counselling session based on their merit.
iii.	The candidates are instructed to visit the website at least two times a day for updates from the date of issue of application till the end of admission process without fail. Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of notices, notification and publications appearing on the website regarding admission to B.N.Y.S. Course 2024-2025 Session.



iv.	One of the Parents or Guardian will be allowed to accompany the candidate to attend the counselling and they should make their own arrangements for attending the counselling session.
v.	Selection will be made by counselling based on merit. Candidates can select a college of their own choice at the time of counseling. However, the allotment is subject to availability of the seats. Option once exercised during counselling, will be final and cannot be changed.
vi.	Those who get Re-totaled / Revalued marks during the first appearance can also attend the counselling on the day and session according to their new marks. If the candidate produces the Re-totaled / Revalued marks after the counselling and within the cutoff date then his/her name, will be considered only in the existing vacancies available and he/she cannot claim any preferential rights for allotment according to merit under re-totaled / revalued marks. Candidates, who submit the Revalued / Re-totaled marks after the administrative cut-off dates fixed by the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi / The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, will not be considered for selection.

Candidates getting allotment, for any other reasons, at a later date after the counselling is over will be given a seat in the existing vacancies available in any one of the colleges irrespective of their merit of marks.</li> <li>2. 17.	All the entries in the application form should be written legibly by the candidate in his/her own handwriting. The candidate should ensure that all information including the marks in the qualifying examination furnished by him/her in the application and the enclosure are correct. The candidate is informed that after scrutiny of his/her application, it is found that the marks furnished by him/her in the application are not correct or any other information is found to be incorrect, then;
a.	He / She will forfeit the admission no matter at what stage of the course he/she will be at that time;
b.	He / She will be debarred from pursuing any studies for a period of three years;
c.	Legal action will be initiated against the candidate and the parents for furnishing incorrect information;
d.	Criminal action will be instituted against him/her for furnishing false documents.

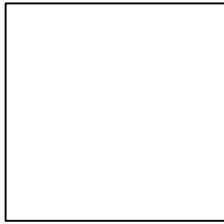

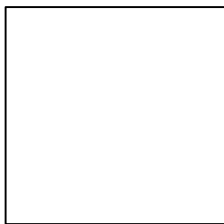

  - v. Enquiry in the village/ place of residence of the neighbour by Village Administrative Officers regarding continuous residing.
  - vi To ensure that wrong or incorrect address had not been furnished to obtain the certificate.
  - vii The birth place of the parent, place of the residence of the parent / father, permanent assets, mother tongue, place of education, place of marriage of the applicant / parents, the period of stay in and outside Tamil Nadu can also be considered before issuing certificate.
